Creators need to challenge themselves, break through the traditional constraints, and create works with depth and breadth in order to win the recognition of the audience.

3 THE RELEVANCE OF HISTORICAL THEMES TO THE CREATION OF DANCE WORKS

Through the creation of historical dance works, the audience can be guided to understand history, recognize history, remember history, thus enhancing national pride and cultural self-confidence. At the same time, it can also stimulate people's patriotic fervor and spirit of struggle, injecting a strong spiritual impetus for social development.

4 PATHS FOR THE CREATION OF DANCE WORKS COMBINING THE HISTORICAL THEMES OF DABIE MOUNTAIN

4.1 Selection of topics and research

To dig deeper into historical resources, creators need to conduct in-depth research on the revolutionary history of the Dabie Mountains, including important historical events, historical figures, revolutionary spirit, etc., by consulting historical documents, visiting local museums, memorial halls, and interviewing historical witnesses. For example, a dance segment can be designed to depict the revolutionary's indomitable spirit in the face of the enemy.		
choreography	Combining regional characteristics and revolutionary elements: incorporating folk dance elements from the Dabie Mountains region, combined with actual movements in revolutionary struggles such as marching fighting, and celebrating victories. Actions should have a strong sense of power and rhythm, accurately conveying the heroic image of revolutionaries.		
choice of music	Integration of revolutionary songs and regional music: Select music works with revolutionary atmosphere as background music, such as "March of the Volunteers", "Red Army Fears No Expedition Difficulties", etc. At the same time, folk music elements from the Dabie Mountains region can be integrated to make the music more regionally distinctive and emotionally profound.		
Stage effect	Creating a revolutionary atmosphere and regional landscape: By using stage scenery, lighting, clothing, and other means, the tense atmosphere of the revolutionary struggle period and the unique landscape of the Dabie Mountains area are created. For example, dark toned lighting and broken scenery can be used to depict the brutality of war, while bright clothing and cheerful music can be used to express the joy of revolutionary		

victory.

Plot arrangement

Storytelling and Scene Transformation: choreographing dance works into a performance with a storyline, showcasing different stages of revolutionary struggle through different scene transformations. For example, one can start from the daily life scenes of revolutionaries and gradually transition to combat scenes, victory celebration scenes, and so on. Each scene should have a clear theme and emotional expression, allowing the audience to follow the rhythm of the dance and feel the ups and downs of the story and emotional fluctuations.

Character Settings

Diversified character images: Set diverse character images, including revolutionary leaders, ordinary soldiers, and peasant masses. Each character should have a distinct personality and characteristics, showcasing their inner world and emotional changes through dance movements and expressions. At the same time, attention should be paid to the interaction and coordination between the characters, making the entire dance work more vivid and touching.

Table 1 shows that in the actual creative process, the plot structure of a dance work needs to be conceptualized according to the selected historical subject and creative theme. The plot can be centered on the development of historical events, or it can focus on a specific historical scene or character. The plot conception should emphasize logic and coherence, and at the same time highlight the unique expressive power of dance art. When choreographing the movement, it can be combined with the existing revolutionary dance theme in depth rendering, so that the performance of the dance movement is more expressive and infectious. The movement design should be in line with the character and emotional changes, while emphasizing the accuracy and vividness of the dance language. Traditional dance elements and modern dance techniques can be borrowed to create dance movements with both a sense of historical importance and a sense of the times.

4.3 Creative practice

Through the use of lighting, scenery, costumes and other elements to create a visual effect in line with the historical background and the theme of the dance.

4.4 Performance feedback

After completing the creative practice, the dance works will be put on the stage for performance. Before the performance, we should make sufficient preparations, including the psychological adjustment of the actors and the debugging of the stage equipment. During the performance, we should pay attention to the audience's feedback and interaction, and adjust the performance status in time to ensure the best presentation of the performance effect. After the performance, collect the feedback from the audience in time. Through questionnaires, talks and other ways to understand the audience's evaluation of the dance works and suggestions. According to the audience feedback on the dance works to make the necessary improvements and perfect. At the same time, we should also pay attention to the evaluation and suggestions of experts and scholars in the industry, and constantly improve the artistic level and social value of the work.

4.5 Dissemination and transmission

Publicize and promote the dance works through various channels, including social media, TV broadcasting and online video platforms. Increase the popularity and influence of the works to attract more attention and appreciation from the audience. Take the dance works as an important carrier to inherit the history and culture of the Dabie Mountain Revolution, and pass them on through performances and teaching. At the same time, it is also necessary to continue to innovate and develop, and inject new vitality and elements into the art of dance. Through the above paths, the dance works with the historical theme of Dabie Mountain have been successfully created and widely disseminated, making positive contributions to the inheritance and promotion of the revolutionary spirit and the development of dance art.
